1. An 18yr old Frodsham man was charged this week with Possession of Controlled Drugs with Intent to Supply. This followed a stop check by my officers in Frodsham last year and he is appearing at Vale Royal Magistrates Court next month.
2. On the subject of drugs my officers stopped a man in the Ship Street area of Frodsham and arrested him in possession of 7 bags of Cannabis. He has been prosecuted.
3. Sightings please for a Blue and White Tipper van with a partial registration number of 'MUM'. This vehicle's occupants called at the address of an elderly lady on Chester Rd Helsby and conned her out of £1000. They took the lady to the Nat West Bank in Frodsham on Monday and made her withdraw £1000 for work that had not been completed on her driveway.
4. We received reports of shoplifting at Helsby petrol station on Wednesday morning. Officers deployed and arrested an Elton man for stealing a can of coke. He was given an instant fixed penalty of £80. A very expensive drink I think!
5. We received a report of a suspicious vehicle in Pytchleys Hollow Norley this week. Two men in a Red Ford Escort Van index number D 51 PWJ pulled onto a lady's driveway and were looking through her window. She approached them and they enquired about repairing her driveway.
