Priority 1 ASB

- **Agreed Proxy Measures**
 - NI 111: First time entrants into CJS
 - NI 17: % of people with a high level of perceived ASB
 - Reported Criminal Damage (approx 16 -17% of all criminal damage in Cheshire West are reporting in Winsford and Rural East)
- **Responses:**
 - ASB Line
 - ASB Operational Panel
 - ASB Victim Panel
 - Community Safety Wardens
 - Making Places Safer

Priority 2 Arson

- Secondary Fires
- In Winsford by the end of February Arson incidents were 31 incidents over target.

Violent crime

- NI 20 Assaults over target in CW&C
 - During 2009/10 Winsford and Rural East counted for approx 14% of all assaults with less serious injuries within Cheshire West
- Proxy measure
 - NI 15 Serious Violent Crime – 17 incidents out of 127 in Winsford (approx 13% of all serious violent crimes)

Communication & Public Confidence

- Special edition of Talking Together
- NI 21
 - Winsford and Rural East 28.2% **slightly better** than the average for Cheshire West 26.9%, The North West 25.7% and England 26.3%
- NI 4
 - Winsford and Rural East 24.2% **slightly worse** than Cheshire West 26.9%, The North West 27.4% and England 28.9%
